Overview

We are seeking a passionate and motivated **Local Community Engagement Coordinator** to lead a community share offer campaign that will raise up to £700,000 to fund additional solar installations. The role is critical in promoting local ownership of renewable energy and ensuring the community benefit societies success through community engagement.

Key Responsibilities

- **Promotion & Outreach:** Develop and deliver a community engagement plan to promote the share offer, aiming to recruit more members from North Lincolnshire postcodes.
- **Event Management:** Organise and lead local face-to-face events, including public meetings, community networking events, and school presentations, to raise awareness about the benefits of renewable energy.
- **Volunteer Mobilisation:** Build and manage a team of local volunteers to support the promotion and campaign activities.
- **Community Partnerships:** Work closely with local businesses, schools, colleges, football clubs, and community groups (e.g., North Lincolnshire Council, local football clubs, and hospice) to enhance public participation in renewable energy projects.
- **Marketing Support:** Assist with the execution of the marketing campaign, including distributing printed materials, digital outreach, and leveraging social media to engage the community.
- **Project Reporting:** Provide regular updates on campaign progress, participation rates, and community feedback, contributing to the quarterly reports.
